



COMMITTEE OF ADJUSTMENT NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING APPLICATION NO. A-051-2022

TAKE NOTICE that an application has been received by the Town of Innisfil from **Stephanie and Richard Veeck, Owners,** for a minor variance from Zoning By-law 080-13, pursuant to Section 45 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended.

The subject property is described legally as PLAN M347 LOT 83, is known municipally as 2111 Gordon Street, and is zoned as "Residential 1 Zone (R1)".

The applicant is proposing to expand an existing second driveway on the property. The applicant is seeking relief from Section 3.18.1(g) of the Zoning By-law which permits a maximum of one driveway per residential lot.

The Committee of Adjustment for the Town of Innisfil will consider this application through a conference call on **Thursday**, **July 21**, **2022**, **at 6:30 PM**.
