TAKE NOTICE that a decision has been made by the Committee of Adjustment, for a minor variance application from **David Iacono**, **Owner**, for relief from the provisions of Zoning By-law 080-13, pursuant to Section 45 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended.

The subject property is described legally as PLAN 767 LOT 91, is known municipally as 1076 Spruce Road, and is zoned as "Environmental Protection (EP)" and "Residential 1 (R1).

The applicant is proposing to construct a new dwelling with two attached garages having a combined width of over 9 m. The applicant is seeking relief from Section 3.18.3(d) of the Zoning Bylaw which permits a maximum garage width of up to 50% of the width of the main wall of the principal building, up to a maximum of 9 m.

NOTICE OF LAST DATE OF APPEAL

In accordance with Section 17 (36) of the Planning Act, you may appeal to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal (LPAT) against the decision by filing with the Secretary Treasurer of the Committee of Adjustment a notice of appeal setting out written reasons in support of the appeal and accompanied by a certified cheque or money order made payable to the Minister of Finance, in the amount of \$400 being the current fee prescribed by the Tribunal under the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal Act. The LPAT prescribed Appellant Form (A1) must be filed with any appeal to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal. This form is available online at www.forms.ssb.gov.on.ca.

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CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

The below Condition(s) of Approval shall be completed within **ONE YEAR** from the Circulation Date of Notice of Decision outlined on Page 1. If the Condition(s) of Approval are not completed by this date, the application shall be deemed to have been refused.

Planning Services

- 1. That the variances only apply to the submitted drawings and that any future development of the lands be subject to Planning Act regulations.
- 2. That the applicant provide a detailed planting plan for the vegetation protection zone of Belle Aire Creek, to provide a buffer to the existing watercourse to the satisfaction of the Town and LSRCA.
- 3. That existing trees be protected and maintained to the satisfaction of the Town. A tree preservation/planting plan shall be prepared to the satisfaction of the Town, proposing tree compensation and replacement rates for any trees to be removed, and location of new trees and tree protection measures during construction of the proposed development.

Engineering Services

- 1. The Applicant/Owner shall prepare and submit engineering design drawings and all other supporting documents in accordance with Town Standards and to the satisfaction of the Town.
- 2. The Applicant/Owner shall undertake and submit a tree inventory, tree preservation, and tree compensation plan to the satisfaction of the Town.

Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority

- 1. That the Applicant/Owner provide the required fee payment for Minor Variance (Minor Planner Review Only) of \$536.00, as per the LSRCA Fee Schedule.
- 2. That a planting plan be prepared for the buffer to the watercourse to the satisfaction of the LSRCA.
- 3. That the applicant/owner successfully obtain a permit from the LSRCA.
