TAKE NOTICE that a decision has been made by the Committee of Adjustment, for a minor variance application from **Daniele Orsini**, **Applicant**, on behalf of **Anita Martello**, **Owner**, for relief from the provisions of Zoning By-law 080-13, pursuant to Section 45 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended.

The subject property is described legally as **PLAN 596 PT BLK A**, is known municipally as **3944 Lakeview Road**, and is zoned as "**Residential 1 (R1)**".

The applicant is proposing to construct a garage addition with a deficient exterior side yard setback. The applicant is seeking relief from Section 4.2(a) of the Zoning By-law which requires a minimum exterior side yard setback of 6 metres.

NOTICE OF LAST DATE OF APPEAL

In accordance with Section 45 (12) of the Planning Act, you may appeal to the Ontario Lands Tribunal (OLT) against the decision by filing with the Secretary Treasurer of the Committee of Adjustment a notice of appeal setting out written reasons in support of the appeal and accompanied by a certified cheque or money order made payable to the Minister of Finance, in the amount of \$400 being the current fee prescribed by the Tribunal under the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal Act. The Tribunal prescribed Appellant Form (A1) must be filed with any appeal to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal. This form is available online at https://olt.gov.on.ca/forms-submissions/.

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CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

The below Condition(s) of Approval shall be completed within **ONE YEAR** from the Circulation Date of Notice of Decision outlined on Page 1. If the Condition(s) of Approval are not completed by this date, the application shall be deemed to have been refused.

Planning

- 1. That the variances only apply to the submitted drawings and that any future development of the lands be subject to the Zoning By-law.
- 2. That any existing trees and boundary trees be protected and maintained to the satisfaction of the Town to provide visual screening to the addition. A detailed tree protection and planting plan shall be prepared to the satisfaction of the LSRCA and Town, proposing tree compensation and replacement rates for any trees to be removed, and location of new trees and tree protection measures during construction.
