TAKE NOTICE that a decision has been made by the Committee of Adjustment, for a minor variance application from **Leanna Mohammed**, **Applicant**, on behalf of **Agostino Dimarsico**, **Owner**, for relief from the provisions of Zoning By-law 080-13, pursuant to Section 45 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended.

The subject property is described legally as **PLAN 767 LOT 55** and is known municipally as **1041 Fern Avenue** and is zoned as "**Residential 1 (R1)**".

The applicant is proposing to construct a detached garage with a proposed Gross Floor Area (GFA) of 117.05 m^2 . The applicant is seeking relief from Section 3.3(b) of the Zoning By-law permits a maximum gross floor area of 50 m^2 for accessory structures in residential zones.
