

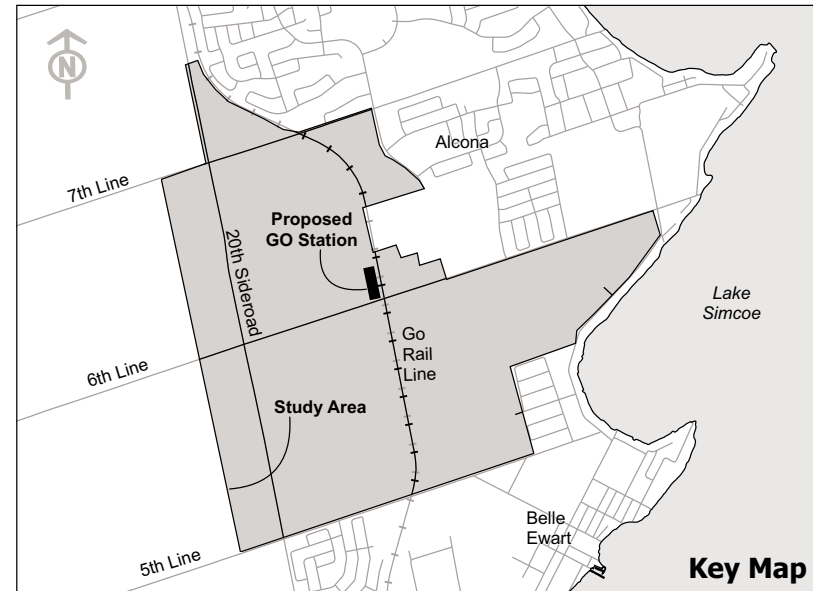
**Innisfil Orbit Potential and Innovation Plan (OPIP)
Servicing Master Plan and Secondary Plan Notice of Public Information Centre**

The Project

The Town of Innisfil has started the Orbit Potential and Innovation Plan (OPIP) that combines the Secondary Plan (planning guidelines) and Master Servicing Plan (MSP) Study (infrastructure needs) to plan for the area around the proposed Innisfil GO Station ('the Project'). The coordinated approach will meet the requirements under both the *Planning Act* and the *Environmental Assessment Act*. The MSP will determine the preferred servicing strategies (water, wastewater, stormwater and mobility) required for the OPIP Secondary Plan Area. The study area is approximately 800 hectares in size and located around the proposed Innisfil GO Station.

Public Information Centre

The purpose of this Notice is to invite you to attend the Public Information Centre (PIC) that will be held to receive input from Indigenous communities, public and interested stakeholders.
