Cookstown Connecting Link Rehabilitation

The Town of Innisfil has contracted Green Infrastructure Partners Inc. (GIP) to complete milling and paving on Queen St. and Church St. (Highway 89) in Cookstown as shown on the map located on the reverse side of this notice. The work will begin September 3, 2024 and is estimated to be completed by October 28, 2024. The contractor will have at least one lane of traffic open at all times.

The work includes resurfacing of the road, pavement marking restoration, replacement of some concrete curb and gutter, and adjustments to existing maintenance holes and catch basins. Areas outside of the roadway that are disturbed such as driveways and boulevards will be restored to existing conditions.

The contractor will be carrying out their work between 7:00am to 8:00pm. Increased noise and some truck traffic can be expected during these hours.

**On-street parking will be prohibited on Queen Street and Church Street
starting September 3, 2024 @ 12:01am.**

Traffic Disruptions

Traffic disruptions will occur during construction. Residents will be given prior notice before any driveway access is restricted.
