## NOTES

- TOWN ENGINEERING TO PROVIDE SWM FACILITY NUMBER.
- USE WORDING "RETROFITTED" FOR EXISTING POND OR "CONSTRUCTED" FOR NEW POND.
- SIGN TO BE LOCATED AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE FACILITY, AS APPROVED BY THE TOWN.
- SIGN TO BE INSTALLED ON TWO 150 MM SQUARE CEDAR POSTS.
- SIGN TO BE 1.2 M HIGH BY 1.8 M WIDE.
- SIGN TEXT DIMENSIONS AND DETAILS TO BE PROVIDED BY THE TOWN.
- SIGN STORM WATER MANAGEMENT FACILITY NUMBER TO BE PROVIDED BY THE TOWN.
- SIGN TO BE LOCATED AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE FACILITY, AS APPROVED BY THE TOWN.
