TOWN OF INNISFIL CONTINUES TO INNOVATE AND INSPIRE! Leadership Succession and Municipal Servicing Corporation Announced

Innisfil, ON (June 18, 2015) – Continuing to embrace innovation and bold new ideas, Innisfil’s Town Council has announced several strategic changes within the Town of Innisfil’s structure.

Council has appointed Mr. Jason Reynar as the Town’s new Chief Administrative Officer (CAO), effective August 1, 2015. Mr. Reynar, currently the Town’s Deputy CAO & Town Solicitor, will collaborate with the Mayor and Council as he leads the organization through the next phase of the town’s transformation and growth, bringing his municipal experience to the next level.

Mr. John Skorobohacz, the Town’s current CAO, will transition to the position of Strategic Advisor. In his new role, Mr. Skorobohacz will ensure that a number of innovative strategies and critical projects continue to move forward, working with the new CAO, to ensure a smooth leadership transition. Mr. Skorobohacz will champion several upcoming strategic projects on behalf of Council and the organization, such as the development of the Campus Node.

As well, Council approved the creation of two Town owned and operated, Municipal Services Corporations—one will operate as “InnServices” delivering the Town of Innisfil’s water and wastewater services, while the other is a holding company. Council has appointed Mr. Andy Campbell, currently Deputy CAO and Town Engineer, to lead “InnServices”, as Chief Executive Officer and President. One of the first opportunities for the newly formed company will be to execute the plan to service Innisfil Heights; the Town’s designated Strategic Employment lands along the Highway 400 corridor.
